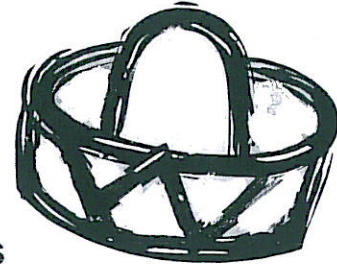




The Mystery of Dos Colores



On October 23, 2010 – should you choose to accept this mission – you will go “undercover” to solve the mystery of Dos Colores. We will begin researching the clues at 9 am and will conclude our investigative activities at 9 pm. Bring your lunch to fuel your sleuthing efforts. We will enjoy an included cocktail conference at 5:30 pm followed by dinner at 6:00 pm. The “Reveal” will begin at 8:15 pm.

You will be making a quilt with two contrasting colors. Choose any type of fabric except DO NOT use a directional print. Lay the two fabrics side by side and check to see if they will play well together, even if you cut them up and sew them back together!

You can border this quilt, and if that is your choice, you will want to have more of the two fabrics. If you want the quilt to “float”, you will need the extra, optional background fabric shown on the list. You have the option of making the quilt in one of three sizes:

- **A:** 51” X 51”
- **B:** 51” X 68”
- **C:** 68” X 85”

You will need to do some pre-cutting and pre-sewing so that you will be ready to cut and sew, and cut and sew! Doesn't this sound so fun!

Supplies:

- A:** 1 1/8 yards dark fabric
2 3/4 yards background (plus another 1/2 yard for “floating”)
1/2 yard either color for binding
Extra fabric for borders, if desired
- B:** 1 1/2 yards dark
3 1/2 yards background (plus another 1/2 yard for “floating”)
1/2 yard either color for binding
Extra fabric for borders, if desired
- C:** 2 1/8 yards dark
5 yards background (plus another 2/3 yard for “floating”)
5/8 yard of either one for the binding
Extra fabric for borders, if desired
